## Procedures

### Arrival to School:

- Gates will be open from 7:30-8:00 for arrival.
- We do not have supervision on campus until 7:30. Please do not drop your child off before the gates are open.

### Car loop:

- All vehicles are required to have a 2022-2023 car tag... if you need one please stop in the front office prior to 2:00.
- Please keep car tags visible until your child has entered the car.
- Parents, please remain in your vehicle. Sabal staff will assist your child getting into the car.
- Students may only enter and exit the car on the passenger side of the vehicle. If your child requires assistance getting in and out of the car please pull forward to the pedestrian crossing beyond the carline.
- Please be patient as we teach routines and procedures. Our system does get better with time, but everyone is learning.

### Visitors on Campus

- Visitors are only permitted for scheduled supervised event.
- No visitors for lunch.
- No visitors walking students to class.

### Birthday Celebrations

- You must reach out to your child's teacher to coordinate.
- If you would like to send in a birthday treat for your child please send it with your child in the morning.



## Clinic Procedures

We will continue to follow the same clinic procedures as we have in the past few years, per student services and the health department. If your child's comes to the clinic with any of the following symptoms they will be sent home for 5 days or may return after a negative covid test or a release from the doctor.

- Fever greater than 100.4
- Chills
- Cough
- Congestion
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore Throat
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Headache
