



Activity Sequence

The diagram below shows the recommended sequence for your Lagoon Quest Program. The pre-test and first six activities should be completed **prior** to your lagoon trip. The last four activities should be completed **after** your trip, when you bring a water sample back to school. The activities in the middle may be done at any time. The post-test should be completed at the end of the unit.

It is expected that all core activities (Lagoonie Quests 1-12) be completed with the teacher option of completing extension activities. **Remember, this supports many NGSSS's in the 4th grade science, social studies, and math and language arts curricula.** The teacher stamp (included in your supply kit) may be used to indicate completion of an activity in each student's booklet. The students will be referred to as "Lagoonies" as they complete the activities in the Quest. Students will become official "Lagoon Keepers" when they have completed the activities in the *Lagoonie Laboratory Logbook*.
