PARENT CORNER

Teaching children how to advocate for themselves without hurting anyone's feelings is something all our children need to be able to do. Making sure in a situation children seek first to understand by asking questions to determine what intent. For example: If student A was pushed from behind by student B. Student A should ask student B "Why did you push me?" Student B says "I tripped over my sneakers, I am so sorry!" Or, student B says "Because you were mean to me!" The first scenario shows that the student didn't mean to cause the other one harm. The second scenario, the student showed intent. Without asking the question one could respond inappropriately. Here is just one of many videos that show the importance of good communication

skills. This can also be emphasized at home if there are siblings in the house or through role playing.
