Principal News

Third Grade students will be taking the FSA English Language Arts Reading Test on Tuesday, April 5th and Wednesday, April 6th. Our Fourth – Sixth Grade students will be taking the Writing portion of the FSA English Language Arts Assessment on Thursday, April 7th. **Please make sure your child is well rested and prepared to test on their scheduled testing dates. Students must be on time since we will begin testing immediately after the morning announcements.** If your child is late to school, they will not be able to interrupt testing and will have to sit up in the front office until testing is completed. If you have any testing questions please contact Mrs. Lizek, our Assistant Principal.

Electronic Devices—Students are not permitted to have any electronic devices, including, but not limited to, cell phones, smartphones, and smartwatches, at any time during testing or during breaks (e.g., restroom), **even if the devices are turned off or students do not use them.** If your student is found with an electronic device, his or her test will be invalidated.

Leaving Campus—If your student begins a test session and leaves campus before completing a session, he or she **will not** be allowed to return to that test session. If your student does not feel well, they can wait and be tested on a make-up day.
