Principal News

It is almost the start of a new school year, and I would like to wish everyone a warm welcome back and look forward to getting to know our new families to our Sea Park community. We are so excited to see the children after summer vacation and hear about their experiences and see how much they have grown! My communication to parents is sent out weekly on Mondays electronically. I encourage parents to get involved in our events and activities throughout the year. Our staff know how important your role is in their success and we strive to work in collaboration with you to help students reach their goals.

Arrival and Dismissal

School begins at 8:00 AM. All classroom doors are locked and any student who comes to school after this time will need to go to the front office for a tardy pass. School is dismissed at 2:30 PM Monday-Thursday and 1:15 PM on Fridays.

Morning Bell Schedule

7:30 Campus opens for students, breakfast begins in the café.

7:45 All classroom doors are open for student entry.

8:00 Late Bell, any student not in class, please head to office for a tardy slip.

Supervision of students begins at 7:30 a.m. Students may enter campus by being dropped off in the car loop, front loop, or entering through the gates on the east and north side of the school. To be on time, all students must be in class by the 8:00 a.m. bell. Students not in the classroom by 8:00 a.m. will need to be escorted to class with a tardy slip. Since all classroom doors are locked for security reasons, knocking on the door to admit tardy students can cause a disruption to the classroom. Thank you for your cooperation and understanding in this matter.

Additional Information Change in Transportation Requests

For your student's safety, a change in transportation request must be made in writing by 2:00 p.m. or 12:45 p.m. on Early Release Days (Fridays). The purpose of having a request made in writing is to ensure student safety by allowing the staff of Indialantic Elementary to verify a person's identity and their relation to the student.

Early Checkout

We begin preparing for dismissal 30 minutes prior to the first bell. To ensure all students arrive home safely, early checkouts will need to be made before 2:00 p.m. on regular dismissal days or 12:45 p.m. on Early Release Days (Fridays). Please plan accordingly so that you can adhere to these guidelines in the event you need to check your student out early.

Rainy Day Dismissal Procedure

Communication to parents will be sent via our Blackboard Connect text message. Once the decision to dismiss for a rainy day is made and communication is sent out, it will remain in progress until all students are picked up or there are no more cars in either loop. All students in grades 1-6 (unless attending aftercare) will be picked up in the west car loop. All VPK or Kindergarten will be picked up in the front car loop.



Students who have siblings in VPK or Kindergarten will be picked up with younger sibling in front car loop. Students who normally ride their bikes or walk to school will be picked up in the front car loop. Students who normally ride their bikes or walk to school will be sent to either the west car loop or the front car loop. Please proceed in your vehicle to the correct location. Thank you for your patience and understanding as student safety is always our number one priority.

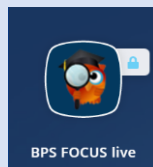

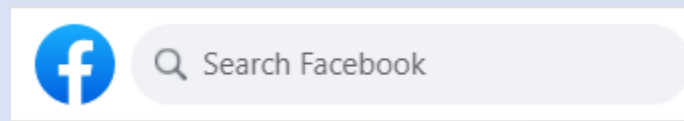
