FAST Testing

On Sept. 7th and Sept. 8th students in grades PreK-2 will be taking the FAST STAR Assessments in Early Literacy or Reading, and Math. The following week students in grades 3-6 will be taking the FAST Assessment of Student Thinking in Reading and Math

on Sept. 13th and Sept. 14th. Please arrive on time on testing days. If students arrive after their class begins testing, they will have to sit in the front office. If you have any questions about the FAST Progress Monitoring Assessments contact Angie Lizek, Assistant Principal at Lizek.angele@brevardschools.org.

Please have your child adhere to the following testing policies:

- **Electronic Devices Policy**—Any student in possession of electronic devices at any time during testing or during breaks will have his or her test invalidated.

- **Leaving Campus**—If students leave campus before completing a test session (e.g., for lunch or an appointment) they will not be allowed to return to that session.

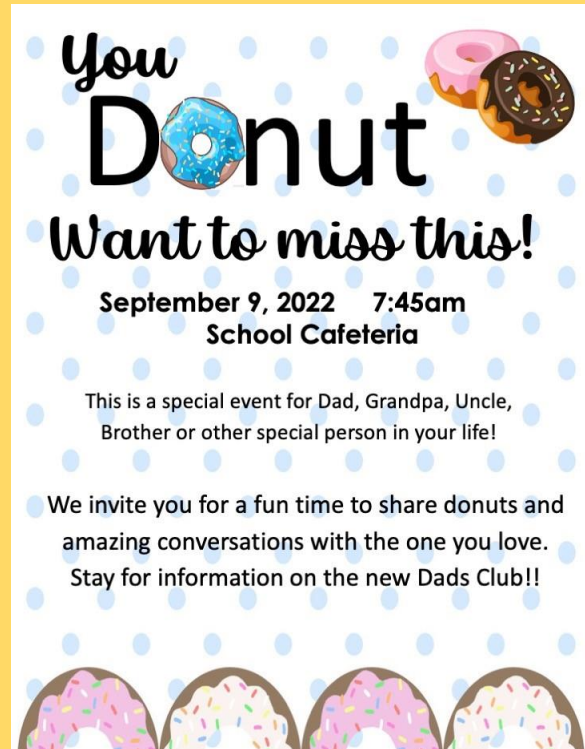
Generous Donation
