Hello BVS Families,

As we begin the second quarter of the school year today, we are going to implement a new process for full-time student attendance. Access to the Launchpad and Focus is working for most but it is inconsistent and solving the access problem is outside of our control. Therefore, effective today, attendance will be measured as follows:

BVS Full-Time Attendance Process - effective 10/11/22

Full-time students are required to work consistently in their courses each week of the school year, regardless of pace, until completion. On average a student would submit between 3-5 assignments in EVERY course, EVERY week. Parent/Guardians are encouraged to monitor your student's active engagement in courses each week through your parent/guardian account. A student who is enrolled in 6 classes, would be submitting an average 20 or more assignments each week. Attendance will be recorded based on a student's active participation in their courses each week.

On the first day of each school week, a student's participation in classes in the previous week will be reviewed. Students who have submitted work in the previous school week, will be marked present. A student who did not submit work in any course, in the previous school week, will be marked absent for that entire week.

This process will be in effect beginning October 11th. Students' attendance for this week will be measured on Monday, October 17th. Students who were actively engaged in classes during the previous week, demonstrated through the submission of coursework, will be marked present from October 11th-14th. Students who have submitted no coursework, will be marked absent October 11th-14th (Oct. 10th was a student holiday) The process will be repeated each week.
