Hurricane Ian Make-Up Days

During the School Board meeting on October 25, 2022, the Board approved the Superintendent's recommendation for Hurricane Ian make-up days. The approved plan is as follows:

- First semester extended until January 9, 2023 (adds two days to first semester - January 6 and January 9. January 5, 2023, the first day back from the winter break was already first semester)
- Conversion of four (4) early release Fridays to regular school days: November 4, 2022; November 18, 2022; December 2, 2022; January 6, 2023

BVS still recommends students attempt to have all coursework submitted by Winter Break. However, student will have 3 days after break for more submissions, segment exams, resubmissions, etc. Segment 2 courses will be ready on January 5th, for those students who are ready to begin all/some of their classes immediately after Winter Break.

BVS Full-Time Attendance Process Update

The new attendance process has been very successful so far! Each week, we have had 99%-100% of our students marked present. As a reminder, on the first day of each school week, a student's participation in classes in the previous week will be reviewed. Students who have submitted work in the previous school week, in any course, will be marked present. A student who submits no work in any course, will be marked absent for that entire week. If a student is marked absent, and we were not previously notified of the planned absence, the parent will be informed via email.

The Dr. Mukesh & Vanita Gaglani Scholarship

BPS is thrilled to announce the Dr. Mukesh & Vanita Gaglani Scholarship and West Shore Teacher & Staff Scholarship!

The Dr. Mukesh & Vanita Gaglani Scholarship is named after the parents of Shiv Gaglani and his sister, Dr. Anushka Gaglani. Shiv graduated from West Shore in 2006 and Anushka graduated from Cocoa Beach International Baccalaureate in 2002. After graduating from Harvard College, Shiv began medical school at Johns Hopkins, where he co-founded [Osmosis.org](https://osmosis.org). This popular learning platform educates millions of students, healthcare professionals, patients, families, and the general public worldwide. A dentist and fellow entrepreneur, Anushka is co-founder & CEO of Areo Dental Group in Chicago, which runs half-a-dozen dental practices and counting.

Together Shiv and Anushka wanted to give back to Brevard students, teachers, and parents by setting up two scholarships. The first, named after their parents, Dr. Mukesh & Vanita Gaglani, who immigrated from India to Africa to the United States, recognizes parental figures who have shaped the lives of BPS students. The second, named after West Shore Teachers & Staff, honors the teachers and staff members who helped shape Shiv's journey at West Shore and beyond. In particular, Shiv was influenced by Mrs. Annie Nery, who helped instill in him a core discipline for overcoming challenges; the late Mr. Jim Melia, who believed anything was possible and in the importance of having fun at work; and Mrs. Sherie Jenkins, who cultivated his love for science and research that ultimately influenced his entrepreneurial journey.

The key requirement of the application is to write a letter of appreciation to your parents, parental figures, or a teacher or staff member articulating the lessons you've learned from them and why you're appreciative. In addition, each applicant will receive complimentary access to advice and strategies around building stronger relationships and other personal & professional development topics - the successful implementation of which will be worth far more than any scholarship.

To be eligible for the scholarship, you must be a Brevard Public School student, complete the application on time, and provide meaningful responses. Each scholarship comes with a \$5,000 cash prize, half of which will be awarded to the winning student and the other half to their parents/parental figures or teacher/staff member who is the subject of their letter of appreciation. Finally, at least one student from West Shore will be awarded a scholarship.

Applications are due February 1, 2023, at 11:59 pm ET and the awards will be announced in May.

MOBILE RESPONSE TEAM

24 Hours 7 Days a Week

The Mobile Response Team (MRT) provides free on-demand and on-site crisis intervention services to children and families in Brevard County 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Services are provided by multi-disciplinary teams of licensed and master leveled behavioral health professionals with specialized crisis intervention training.

SERVICES:

- Services are Free
- Target response time within 60 minutes or less
- Evaluation and Assessment
- Development of Safety or Crisis Plans
- Stabilization Services
- Supportive Crisis Counseling
- Education
- Development of Coping Skills
- Development of Care Plan
- Linkage to Appropriate Resources
- Care Coordination

Eligibility:

MRT serves youth or young adult ages 25 and under.

The MRT is designed to address a wide variety of situations to include, suicidal and homicidal behaviors, drug and alcohol abuse, disruptive behaviors related to thought, mood and anxiety disorders, individuals displaying hallucinations, family/peer conflicts, and escalating behaviors without immediate intervention, the individual is likely to require a higher intensity of services.

MRT is available to anyone who calls for assistance: Parent, Relative, Foster Family, School/Medical Personnel, Child and Adult Protection Staff, and Law Enforcement.
