AVID students are enrolled in rigorous curriculum as well as an AVID elective class. The AVID elective class provides academic instruction, tutorial support, organization, college and career readiness, and motivational activities.

Who Qualifies for AVID? Students who:

- Have the potential and desire to attend a 4-year college or university
- Display appropriate classroom behavior
- Have a 2.0 GPA or higher
- Have a good attendance record
- Demonstrate excellent work, ethic, and good behavior
- Can work independently and collaboratively
- Are from families historically underserved in colleges and universities
- Would like to get support in their present courses and take advanced courses with assistance in middle school
- Complete the application and interview process
- Will commit to at least one high school credit course in middle school
- Have PM scores in mid-range (high level 2 – low level 4)
