



GOLFVIEW ELEMENTARY SCHOOL UNIFORM VIOLATION

Golfview Elementary School is a uniform school. Each student is required to be in uniform unless there is a legitimate excuse for them being out of uniform. The following will be administered for violating Golfview's dress code.

- **First uniform violation:** Student will be sent to the front office with their agenda where they will receive a verbal warning and a violation form to take home in their planner/agenda for parent review.

Violations: Wearing the wrong pants/skirts with the uniform shirt

Wearing a hoodie/jackets when outdoors

Uniform not worn

- **Second uniform violation:** Student will be sent to the front office where a parent will be called to bring in the appropriate clothing/shoes. Student in violation will wait in the front office for the clothing/shoes from home to arrive and once changed will return to their classroom. If the parent does not come with the appropriate clothing. In-school detention will be issued. Student will report to room 601 for the in-school detention. Room number is subject to change.

Violations: Uniform not worn

Jeans worn with uniform (except on Fridays)

Hoodie, jackets, pullover sweater being worn with the uniform

outside

- **Third uniform violation:** Student will be given a before or afterschool detention. Parent will still be called to bring in the appropriate clothing/shoes.

Violations: Repeat offender from first and second violations.

- **Repeated uniform violations:** Student will be referred to administration for further review and possible out-of-school suspension.

Violation: Parent/Student not adhering to Golfview Uniform Policy.
