FSA/EOC Remediation (Placement based on 2022 scores).

- Students who scored a Level 1 or Level 2 on the 2022 FSA ELA will automatically be placed in Intensive Reading.
- Placement will be updated with the 2023 B.E.S.T. ELA scores in June and Intensive Reading letters will be sent in the mail.
- Students who took, but did not pass Algebra 1 in 8th grade may retake Algebra 1 in 9th grade.

High School Credit in Middle School

Students may be eligible for high school credit retrieval or grade forgiveness to replace a C, D or F in a class that carries high school credit. It is important to protect your high school GPA for eligibility in dual enrollment opportunities and extracurricular activities.

Online Course Graduation Requirement

Cohort 2027 students are required to take at least one online course. Students may take it outside of the school day, through Brevard Virtual School. Students may elect to take online courses during the school day, outside of the school day, or during the summer.
