



EARLY ADMISSION APPLICATION CHECKLIST

Application Deadline – Thursday, May 11, 2023

1) MEET ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Early Admission applicants **MUST** have:

1. A state cumulative unweighted high school GPA of 3.0 or higher by the end of the 11th grade.
2. College-ready test scores in Reading, Writing, and Math on the PERT, ACCUPLACER, SAT, or ACT.
3. Brevard Public School (BPS) students must have completed all required subject-area graduation credits by August 10, 2023 except for:
 - 1.0 high school credit in English
 - 1.0 high school credit in Science
 - 1.0 high school credit in Math
 - 1.0 high school credit in Social Studies

BPS students may complete the above credits through equivalent EFSC courses while in Early Admission. Private school and home education students must have met the course completion requirements set forth by their school or identified in their home education program.

2) COMPLETE THE APPLICATION PROCESS BY THE MAY 11, 2023 DEADLINE

Include the following three (3) documents in your packet:

1. **EFSC Early Admission Application:** Provide your B Number and well-written essay responses.
2. **Early Admission Eligibility Evaluation:** Completed and signed by your high school counselor.
3. **Early Admission Student/Parent Agreement:** Signed by you and your parent/legal guardian.

Students may submit their application packet using any of the options below:

- **Drop off** the three application documents as a packet to any EFSC Campus Welcome Desk
- **Email** the packet with all documents saved as PDF attachments (*no pictures or screen shots*) to Donna C. Binninger at binningerd@easternflorida.edu

3) SUBMIT EARLY FOR “EARLY ACCEPTANCE” NOTIFICATION

To find out early if you have been accepted, submit your application packet before the May 11 deadline. Early acceptance allows your counselor to complete your registration form with 4 or more classes before the registration window opens.

IMPORTANT! CHECK YOUR STUDENT TITAN EMAIL ACCOUNT TO FIND OUT IF YOU HAVE BEEN ACCEPTED INTO THE EARLY ADMISSION PROGRAM. THE COLLEGE WILL NOT SEND ACCEPTANCE INFORMATION TO YOUR PERSONAL EMAIL ADDRESS!

4) PENDING STATUS

Submit your application packet by the Thursday, May 11, 2023 deadline. If you do not have the required 3.0 high school GPA or test scores, the College will place your application in a Pending file. Once you meet eligibility criteria and you notify the Dual Enrollment Office of this change in status, we will process your application and notify you of your acceptance.
