UNIFORM REFRESH!

We have noticed many students out of uniform daily, so we are going to do UNIFORM CHECKS for up to 2 days of FREE DRESS prior to Spring Break (see graphic). You can also look at the student handbook for the full uniform policy but here are some noticing's that are **NOT** considered proper uniform:

**Elastic waist pants/shorts grades 1-6
Missing belts grades 1-6
Untucked shirts grades 1-6
Socks that are not SOLID white or black
Shoes that are not SOLID white or black
Excessive costume jewelry
Boots (mostly girls)
Hoodies of any kind
Jackets that are not black or blue on days warmer than 60 degrees

For a class to receive FREE DRESS March 18-20, the WHOLE class must be in uniform during the inspection. This is a school-wide expectation that is communicated regularly. It takes the whole team. Let's pull it together friends!

COMING SOON! FREE DRESS UNIFORM CHECKS

Full school uniform checks will occur prior to Spring Break. Classes will have the opportunity to earn 2 free dress days between March 18-20. The whole class MUST be in uniform for the class to earn FREE DRESS!


- Black or White Socks (ankle to below the knee)
- Solid Black or White Shoes- Sneakers for safety- No Boots-Lace/soles must match shoe.
- Belts in belt loops- 1st-6th on "uniform" style shorts and pants. Shorts and pants may NOT be elastic or drawstring. Khaki jeans not included or permitted.
- Shirts tucked in 1-6
- Black or White leggings or tights are permitted under skirts/shorts
- Navy or Black non-hoodie jackets unless it is under 60 degrees.
- Black, White, Blue or Red hair accessories
