- ASP
 - Begins December 4 through the end of April. Students will stay afterschool once weekly on Wednesday's (alternating reading/ math) from 2:30- 4:00 pm. Bus transportation has been approved and will be provided to make ASP as accessible as possible. Currently approx. 45 students signed up to attend. About 30 students who have been identified per grade level (3,4,5,6) were invited.
- School Wide Writing Day
 - On Nov 5 students in grades 3-6 took a mock Writing FSA test (120/ 90 minutes). The rubric was utilized to improve writing. Teachers will take samples and model revision of writing. Next mock FSA writing day is 1/29/2020.
- SAC Requests
 - Iready Incentives- 1 student per classroom will be nominated for a certificate and plush toy for growth. Committee discussed using Amazon or other vendors for more cost effective options for older students. \$300 approved by all members towards incentives.
 - Building Vocabulary Curriculum- Mrs. Slentz requests \$499.82 to purchase a supplemental vocabulary program, called Building Vocabulary. 4th grade is looking to purchase 1 teacher set and 22 student instruction books. With taxes, the program will cost \$549.80 and was approved by all members.
