- COVID-19 School Update

Schools are currently closed due to the Coronavirus pandemic. Students are learning either remotely or through work packets. We currently have nine students on work packets. All other students are working through technology. Teachers are required to have an online presence for 3 hours per day to stay accessible to students' needs. The other 5 hours of the day, teachers are working on planning, accommodations, monitoring data, and providing supports for students. Attendance is taken daily through FOCUS or through contact with packet students. Teachers are continually monitoring data to check for understanding and provide assistance where necessary. Grades are being taken on submitted work. Teachers are working remotely and their last day on campus was Friday, April 3, 2020.

There has been no notification as to when the non-essential quarantine will be lifted and students may return to school. As of now, the projected date is May 4, 2020. This is a state decision and Gov. DeSantis will make the final determination as to when to open our schools.

Our building is currently closed and our office staff is working remotely starting Tuesday, April 7, 2020. The phones are forwarded to Google Voice accounts and we still can be

reached through phones and email. Administration is following the same plan as our office staff.

Custodians are sanitizing and cleaning the classrooms. Once the rooms are sanitized, the custodians are sealing the rooms and no one will be allowed to enter. District facilities will be shutting down all systems except for the food service area.

The district food services department is handing out meals for students and families in our car loop. All students under the age of 18 qualify for this program.

We will continue to update parents on Blackboard Connect and through our website.

- FSA Cancelled

The state of Florida has cancelled FSA for this school year. Students / schools will not be penalized for not taking / administering the FSA this year. Promotion and retention decisions will be decided as we always do, through a compilation of all data and input from administration, teachers, and parents.

- Site Analysis

District will be holding a Site Analysis in an effort to find a principal for next school year. The site analysis will be done remotely. Parents and teachers will receive information soon through Blackboard Connect, and our school website.
