New Business:

Mrs. Lea presented more information regarding the Site Analysis. She notified the SAC that the new Principal had been identified and that it would be going to the School Board on Friday. Announcement to the faculty will be on the following Tuesday.

School budget was reviewed and approved. Cristie Sinclair motioned and Shannon Campbell seconded the motion. All voted in favor.

Discussion was held about tentative plans for summer learning opportunities. More information will be going out to parents from district once plans are finalized.

Discussion was held regarding possible school reopening. It was shared that the wishes of the district is to begin again in August as planned. Information will come from the governor and the state as to what the process for reopening schools will be.

Membership for the 2020-2021 SAC was discussed. The new principal will conduct her elections at the beginning of the school year. The tentative dates were planned for the 3rd Thursday of each month (excluding December) at 2:45 pm. This is subject to change, as new administration will need to make the final decision.

Mrs. Slentz discussed the Parent Insight Survey results. She noted that the three things that the school will continue to focus on would be: continuing and increasing family engagement

events, offering more in the way of math instructional supports, looking at a variety of meeting times so more parents have an opportunity to participate.

Mrs. Loggins reviewed the Title 1 Comprehensive Needs Assessment (CNA) and the 20019-2020 Title 1 Program Evaluation. A discussion was held regarding concerning needs for the 2020-2021 school year. Some concerns were putting an emphasis on Social / Emotional PBIS supports and Academic Enrichment Activities. Further discussion was held regarding holding seminars for parents so they can support their students with their math homework. Additional conversations were held regarding before or after school tutoring. The consensus was to continue efforts toward academic support of the lowest 25%.

Mrs. Lea ended the meeting by thanking all of the SAC members for their support this year.
