Sharon Forand opened the meeting at 3:30 p.m., welcoming members and guests. She reviewed
the minutes from the previous SAC (School Advisory Council) meeting on December 18, 2023.
 Deputy Laurie DiSalvo motioned to approve the minutes, and Roxanne Blaile seconded the
motion.

School Improvement Plan (SIP)

- Sharon Forand shared with the committee information pertaining to the goals and intent of the SIP as it relates specifically to science.
- The SIP is on our school website should members want to review this prior to our next meeting. It is located under the "About Us" tab.
- Science proficiency was the most improved data component (74% compared to 52% in the previous school year). This is the highest proficiency that Enterprise has had in 7 years.
- Actions Enterprise instructional staff took to work toward the increase included:
 - o All 5th grade students had the opportunity to participate in Science Blitz
 - ASP was offered during the school day, with a focus on 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade science standards
 - Students completed Science Fair projects to practice the scientific method.
 - Time was built into the schedule for more inquiry and science activities in 5th grade.
- We will continue using these strategies to maintain or increase student performance and understanding of science concepts. New this year is that 5th-grade students participate in weekly science labs.
