Welcome

- Sharon Forand opened the meeting at 3:31 p.m., welcoming members and guests. She reviewed the minutes from the previous SAC (School Advisory Council) meeting on November 27, 2023. Christa Jackson motioned to approve the minutes, and Deputy Laurie DiSalvo seconded the motion.

School Improvement Plan (SIP)

- Kelli Dufresne shared with the committee information pertaining to the goals and intent of the SIP as it relates specifically to Math.
- Kelli Dufresne informed the committee that we will focus on Science during our next meeting.
- The SIP is on our school website should members want to review this prior to our next meeting. It is located under the “About Us” tab.
- Drew White asked what it looks like when students are pulled from classes for additional instruction. Mrs. Dufresne described small group activities and additional supports held during school and after school, such as ASP (Academic Support Program). In addition, our school works with Space Coast Jr./Sr. High School students who are in an education program called ATEPS (Academy of Teacher Education and Public Service). Once a week, these high school students push into classrooms to support math.
- Kelly Savage asked what grades were being served through the ASP program. Mrs. Blaile explained that the last cycle focused on 1-6th grade students, and this upcoming cycle will be centered around the needs of students in grades 3-6, as they prepare for testing. Invitations were based on data from teacher recommendations from data shared at PLT meetings.

School Grades

- Kelli Dufresne shared that the DOE released informational school grades for last year based on the PM3 FAST assessment for grades 3-6 and 5th grade Science. Last year was a baseline year, and only Reading, Math, and Science proficiency (3 and above) was used to calculate school grades.

- Kelli Dufresne was happy to announce that Enterprise earned an “A” again this year. We have a lot to be proud of!
