- Mrs. Williams welcomed the committee and requested that members review the minutes from our last meeting. She also shared with us that we have new staff members this year. Lori Fox is teaching 5th grade, Lois Shell is our short-term PE teacher, and Deputy Laurie Ryba is our School Resource Officer. We are very excited to have them join the Enterprise family.
- Mrs. Dufresne shared the current enrollment numbers as of today, August 31st. The numbers are:

- Mrs. Smith informed the committee that the kindergarten FLKRS screening will begin on September 14th. The testing window is open until October 9th.
- Mrs. Smith also shared that this year we will be hosting a virtual Science and Engineering Fair Parent Meeting on September 22nd, at 5:30pm.

- Mrs. Dufresne informed the committee that our SAC committee will be accepting new members. We had 6 parents who expressed interest in joining our SAC committee, as well as some teachers. Nominations have taken place, and ballots will be going out soon. We are hoping to determine new representatives on September 21st. Of course, the meetings are open to parents and teachers in the Enterprise community, and they can attend as guests.
- Mrs. Dufresne expressed that parents have shown interest in joining our PTO, and that she will be reaching out to our current board to determine how PTO Board elections would be held as well as dates and times for virtual meetings.
- Mrs. Smith informed the committee of changes to our school safety plan. This year teachers have received a “Go Kit” bag for their classroom. We will have one fire drill and one critical incident drill every month.
- Mrs. Smith also shared that our School Improvement Plan will continue to focus on writing across the content areas, but we are adding ASP tutoring programs into our SIP. The district has allotted additional funds for ASP. The draft of the SIP is due on September 18th.
- Mr. Spinale shared a thank you from his family regarding e-learning and communications between school and home.
- Mrs. Dufresne shared that a parent expressed concerns through email regarding date and time SAC meetings were held. Mrs. Dufresne explained SAC agendas and minutes are posted on our school website. The meeting date and time is mutually agreed upon the members of the committee.
