- Mrs. Dufresne opened the meeting at 3:35 pm, welcoming members and guests.
- Nichole Villegas reviewed the minutes from the August 2022 SAC (School Advisory Council) meeting. William Scheiner motioned to approve the minutes, and Laurie DiSalvo seconded the motion.
- Mrs. Dufresne welcomed the new members of the committee and shared the School Advisory Council By-Laws.

School Improvement Plan

- Mrs. Smith shared the Science Focus of this year's School Improvement Plan (SIP). This decision was made in response to a decline in student proficiency in science as indicated on SSA Science Achievement. She outlined the strategies, rationale, and action steps to implement the 5E Instructional Model to address the Area of Focus, as well as using Science Benchmark Block District Assessments to monitor student progress.
- Mrs. Smith addressed questions from the committee concerning resources and enrichment that will be made available to teachers, and students, and extended to families. In the classroom, teachers in grades 3-6 will utilize Penda Science, 5th grade teachers have designed Science ASP (Academic Support Program) to review content from

3rd-5th grade standards. Activity teachers will collaborate with grade-level teams to support science vocabulary instruction schoolwide. This year, science projects will return, starting in the classroom and extending beyond our school walls.

Financial Requirements and Needs

- The committee has a beginning balance of \$0. We expect to receive additional SIP funding in the next few weeks.
