Celebrate Literacy Week Outcome

- Mrs. Dufresne shared that our school Literacy Leadership Team did an amazing job planning our Literacy Week events which included our Family Night with grade level literacy-based challenges that students had to complete to “escape the school.” She also shared that we started an annual “One Book. One Team.” schoolwide reading initiative with “The Lemonade War” text. We had a different staff member read each

chapter and record themselves so that all families could participate. These videos were posted on Class Dojo. We had 185 out of 552 students participate in this initiative.

- Mrs. Dufresne shared that new legislative language states that any new books not currently in our school library catalog will be reviewed by SAC. This will be a running agenda item should we have any books that need to be discussed each month.

Longitudinal FAST Results PM1 – PM2

- Mrs. Smith shared with the committee our FAST PM1 and PM2 data. She discussed that each grade level increased in scale score for both reading and math. She analyzed each grade level reading and math data to show the increases and decreases we are seeing in each grade level and our next steps for supporting student learning.
