Registration Now!



Children entering kindergarten for the first time must comply with Florida Statute 1003.21 regarding age, which states a child must be five years old on or before September 1. All children who will be six years old by February 1 of the school year, must attend school regularly during the entire school term.

Items needed for kindergarten registration:

- Original birth certificate or acceptable evident/documentation
- Compulsory immunizations
- Current physical
- Two forms of residence verification

July 2	Deadline for New Applicants to Accept or Decline Offered Seat via Family Dashboard
June 22 – July 17	Waitlist Applications open for Elementary Schools
July 28	Last day for Schools to Offer Seats from Waitlist (based on space availability)

WBEE News Crew Feature HENRY CHRISTIANSEN



As you know, every school day our Holland WBEE News Team is busy investigating and reporting the news to Holland's community. This week, we would like to introduce Henry Christiansen, 6th grade student, and WBEE anchor reporter!

Five days each week, Henry films his portion of the WBEE news each morning. First, he makes sure that his set up is the way he wants it. He checks to see that the white sheet he uses as his "backdrop" is neatly hung over his window to ensure that professional look.

Next, Henry uses two desk lamps to confirm that the lighting in his recording studio is just right. Lighting is very important as it either positively or negatively affects the way his video will look. Henry uses a tripod from an old camera to hold his iPhone. The iPhone is clipped using a phone clip from his mom's bike. Very inventive, Henry!

Then comes the practice session! Since Henry has the same segment each day, Holland's Kindness Corner and final announcements, he reviews any new names or words to make sure he pronounces them correctly in his recording. He usually records it perfectly in the first try however, sometimes he will record his segment a second time just to ensure it's as good as possible. When Henry feels that he has the best recording, he uploads it into Microsoft Teams, which is one of the sites the news crew uses for team communications. We thank you, Henry, for your dedication in bringing us the latest and greatest from our Holland Hornets!!
