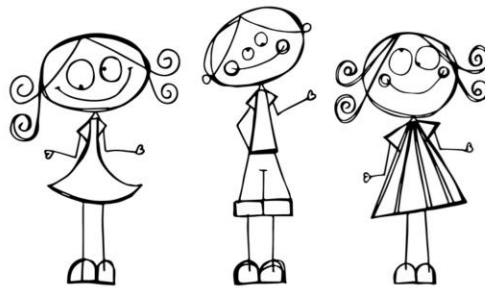
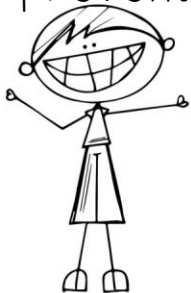


# What is PBIS?

The Positive Behavior Intervention and Support program is being implemented every day at Sunrise. We are teaching students to Be Safe, Work Hard, and Be Kind. We begin teaching these expectations to your children on the first day of school, and we continue to reinforce them throughout the year. Student expectations are demonstrated through staff and peer modeling and acknowledgement of positive behaviors. At Sunrise we are focusing on prevention not punishment.



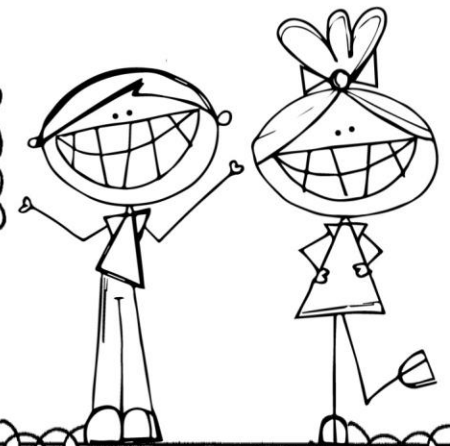

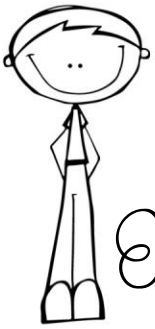

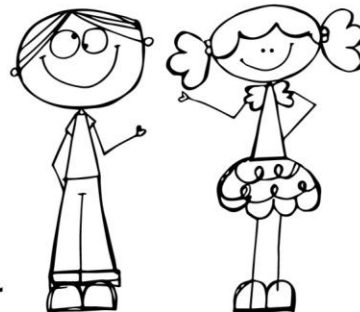
# Student Expectations

- Understanding feelings and the feelings of others.
  - Following directions.
- Ignoring distractions.
  - Apologizing.
- Dealing with teasing.
- Accepting consequences.
- Contributing to classroom discussions.
  - Reporting.
- Making good choices.
  - Avoiding trouble.
- Asking for permission.
  - Dealing with anger.
  - Joining an activity.
- Giving and accepting a compliment.
- Coping with peer pressure.
- Conflict Resolution.

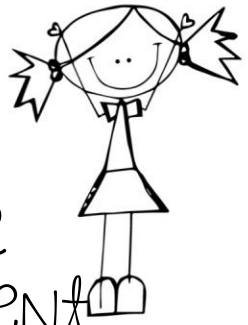
It is not fair to expect anyone to exhibit a behavior which has never been taught or reinforced.

# PBIS Goals

- To create a proactive school and classroom environment for all students.
- To improve the climate of the school by establishing a learning environment that is positive, preventive and predictable to improve student behavior.
  - Reduce unnecessary punishments such as discipline referrals, detentions, suspensions, and expulsions.
- Increase academic instruction time and reduce classroom behavior management time.
- Enhance the continuum of behavior support for students who display significant behavior challenges.
