If we cannot guarantee 6 feet of social distancing, what recommendations does your SAC have for re-opening guidelines for: Transportation

Taking temperature, optional masks—question of how they are provided raised, maximize distance between students, hand sanitizer stations strategically placed

If we cannot guarantee 6 feet of social distancing, what recommendations does your SAC have for re-opening guidelines for: Cafeteria

Hand sanitizer, maximize distance—Temporarily suspend Anchor Hour and go back to split lunches with two or three lunches to allow for less students in the cafeteria at any given time. Distance between students in line, remove some tables in Senior patio, eat in teachers' room if agreeable (survey regarding interest perhaps during Pre-planning), limit the number of students per table—question raised of ability to enforce. Placing tables in strategic locations to further distance students.

If we cannot guarantee 6 feet of social distancing, what recommendations does your SAC have for re-opening guidelines for: Class Change (Secondary)

Not allowing students to lag in hallways in large groups, discourage hanging out between classes with hall monitors at high traffic areas, get to class ASAP,

If we cannot guarantee 6 feet of social distancing, what recommendations does your SAC have for re-opening guidelines for: Classrooms with unique configurations such as Music, Art, CTE, etc..

Maximize distance between students, have teachers brainstorm ideas regarding utilizing more demonstrations, less whole group activity, hand sanitizer, optional masks,

What other concerns does your team have?

If there is a second wave of infections near Winter time what do we do then?—Perhaps dismissing after Thanksgiving until after Christmas.

Drive-thru registration was floated as an option to help during registration minimize contact.

What other suggestions does your team have?

Opportunity to clean out classrooms, a conscience effort on every teachers part to get rid of materials that aren't really utilized.

Suggestion to go more towards virtual learning, digital platform/Google Classroom/FOCUS, less hard copy/paper handouts to minimize the potential transmission of germs. One to one devices--gave out about 240 computers.

Return to activity form for athletic participation in three separate phases. Coaches take on additional responsibility in ensuring student safety.

Motion to move residual rollover funds into the general supply account passes unanimously.
